1. **Entry tickets** are available at the Bemboka Memorial Hall on Saturday 29th October 2016 from 9.00am till 11.00am and also on Sunday 30th October from 8.00am till 10.00 am.
 - * Entry fee 20c
 - * First prize \$3.00
 - * Second prize \$1.50
2. **Exhibits** must be staged by 10.00 am on Sunday for judging at 10.30am.
3. No entries to be taken from the hall after judging till 3.00pm.
4. All exhibits except floral art must be grown by the exhibitor.
5. All cut flowers must be in unmarked containers.
6. **Champion Rose** to be awarded to the best exhibit of classes 1 - 19.
7. **Champion Cut Flower** to be awarded to the best exhibit of classes 31-51.
8. **Floral Art** - all fresh flowers and foliage must be used unless otherwise stated. Embellishment may be added.
9. **Selected flowers** available for sale from 3.00 pm.
